Prime Minister's Announcement – National Lockdown

Firstly, I hope that you all managed to have a good half term with your family and are now ready for the term ahead of us.

I am writing to you following the Prime Minister's announcement on Saturday evening that England will be entering a national lockdown from **Thursday 5th November**.

I know that this announcement might cause uncertainty for some of you over the coming days and weeks and I wanted to assure you of the following things:

1. Our commitment to providing a safe learning environment for your child remains our priority. We will continue to follow the latest guidance and advice and remain committed to our safety procedures in place.
2. Our learning platform Class DoJo (Tapestry for EYFS) continues to be used and our Learning Zone on our website continues to be developed and updated. These are all ready to be used to ensure that learning continues for your child(ren) should they need to self-isolate at home.
3. I will do my best to keep you as up-to-date as possible and, please remember, myself and the team are available should you have any concerns or worries.

I wish to thank you for your support and resilience in these challenging times. There may be further challenges ahead but by working together we can work through them. I would ask that parents follow the following simple steps to support our school community at this time.

1. Wear a face covering (unless you have a medical reason not to)
2. Arrive at your staggered time and minimise time spent on the school grounds.
3. Maintain a 2m distance from people you do not live with to help stop the transmission of Covid-19.
4. Follow the guidelines on childcare support and only share a car with people you live with or your support bubble if a single parent.
5. Only come into the reception area when a telephone call or e-mail to the office will not suffice.
