Please find below information regarding the concert your child will be attending on Friday 13th January at the Resorts World Arena (formerly known as Genting Arena) in Birmingham.

Schedule

12.00 noon	Leave Little Hill
1.00 p.m.	Arrive at Resorts World Arena and have lunch
2.15 p.m.	Rehearsals begin
5.00 p.m.	Children will have an hour break to eat their packed meal
7.00 p.m.	Concert commences and will finish approximately at 8.45 p.m.

The earliest estimated time we will arrive back at Little Hill is 10.15 p.m. although this may be later – we will keep you informed on the day. Please be prepared that your child will have a long day, they will need two lots of packed lunches and snacks, including drinks (**no glass bottles are permitted in the arena**). Please note children will have to store their bags and coats under their seat at the arena.

Dress code

Please can children come to school in their Young Voices t-shirts or a plain white top with their uniform. Jumpers, cardigans and fleeces can be worn, but must be removed before the concert begins. Children are asked not to wear hats, flashing headbands or neon clothing.
