## SPRING TERM CLUBS

We are really excited to announce a host of new sporting clubs for the Spring Term. As well as continuing to offer the most popular clubs from the Autumn Term, we are introducing many new ones. Teachers have spent time asking their class to vote for the sporting club they would like to attend. The sporting clubs are: Football (girls, boys and mixed), Tennis, Cheerleading, Netball, Dance, Basketball (coached by the Leicester Riders), Gymnastics, Archery, Tag Rugby, Multi-Skills, Hockey and Judo.

**STEM** club – Aveea is a company that runs hands on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics experiments, to inspire pupils into the world of STEM. There will be a KS2 Assembly on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> January, giving children a sneak peek at the cool and exciting equipment they will explore in the club and the amazing designs that they will get to make (please book via [www.aveea.org](http://www.aveea.org) from the date of the assembly).

Please study the Spring Clubs table and select with your child/ren which ones they would like to attend. Taking part in sport is an essential part of education, not just for the physical benefits, but for their mental and emotional health too. Hopefully, there are many that take their fancy!

There are limited places for each club, so sign up fast! First come, first served. Sign up by submitting payment via MCAS, or send cash or cheque to the office with the attached form. When making a payment via MCAS, there is now an option of paying weekly or for the term. The clubs will run until the end of the academic year. In the unlikely event of any date changes, we will let you know. Please understand that if there is not enough uptake for a club, it will not be able to run.

Once your child has joined a club we will expect them to attend on a regular basis; they will not be able to change to another club once it has started. There will be no refunds given should your child not wish to continue in their chosen club.

## PUPIL PREMIUM

If your child is Pupil Premium, please complete the form and return to the office, payment will be half the price stated for each club. Once your child's place is confirmed, you will be able to make payment via MCAS, or cash or cheque to the office. Thank you.

## ARRANGEMENTS FOR AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

Please note that it will not be possible for children to stay for after school clubs unless we have received payment and your written permission for them to do so. You will also need to confirm that you have made appropriate arrangements for your child to be collected when the club has ended – **NB a crossing guide will not be on duty at this time.**



Should staff need to cancel a club for any reason we will notify you via MCAS so that appropriate supervision arrangements can be made. Please indicate on the form attached if this is not convenient. If your child is in Year 5 or 6 and you wish to give permission for them to walk home, please complete the attached clubs form and return to the school office. Thank you.

### **SAFETY NOTICE**

Children who have are asthmatic or have an AAI (Epipen) pen will need to take responsibility for their own inhalers/AAI pens whilst participating in any of the clubs mentioned above and all inhalers/AAI pens need to be marked with your child's name. It will also be appreciated if you would bring any specific medical matters to the attention of club leaders whenever you consider this to be appropriate.
