Please understand that if there is not enough uptake for a club, it will not be able to run.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Once your child has joined a club we will expect them to attend on a regular basis; they will not be able to change to another club once it has started. **There will be no refunds given should your child not wish to continue in their chosen club.** Your child may join another club if there are spaces, but please note, payments are not transferrable. Unless your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium, full payment will need to be made for the club.

## **COLLECTION/WALKING HOME ARRANGEMENTS**

Please note the new timings of the clubs are 3.20 – 4.20 p.m. with the exception of Judo which is 3.25 – 4.25 p.m. The gates will be opened at 4.15 p.m. to allow parents to walk round to collect their children from the classroom and outdoor area (as shown on the club information page). Please be prompt when collecting your child. **If your child is in year 5 or 6 and you wish to give permission for them to walk home, please complete the form attached and return to the school office.** Thank you.

## **JEWELLERY**

Please could we draw your attention to our policy regarding earrings: We strongly advise that jewellery should not be worn to school for health and safety reasons. If you choose for your child to wear earrings, only stud earrings are allowed. If your child needs to wear any medical or religious jewellery, then an appointment needs to be made to speak with us. We strongly advise that all watches and earrings should be removed for physical activities. **Please could your child put surgical tape over the piercing themselves or remove any jewellery before the club begins.** Thank you.

## **PUPIL PREMIUM**

If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium, payment will be half the price stated for each club, with the exception of KS2 Gymnastics on Wednesdays.

## **ARRANGEMENTS FOR AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS**

**Please note that it will not be possible for children to stay for after school clubs unless we have received payment and your written permission for them to do so.** You will also need to confirm that you have made appropriate arrangements for your child to be collected when the club has ended – **NB a crossing guide will not be on duty at this time.**

## **SAFETY NOTICE**

Children who have are asthmatic or have an AAI (Epipen) pen will need to take responsibility for their own inhalers/AAI pens whilst participating in any of the clubs mentioned above and all inhalers/AAI pens need to be marked with your child's name. It will also be appreciated if you would bring any specific medical matters to the attention of club leaders whenever you consider this to be appropriate.
