Year 2 Residential Trip

Dear Parent/Carer

Excellent news! We have secured a booking for the next Year 2 cohort, the current Year 1s, to go on a one-night local residential trip.

It will take place at Beaumanor Hall (Woodhouse Eaves) which is approximately 20 miles away from Little Hill.

The dates are as follows: leave school on **Tuesday 24th October** and return the next day on **Wednesday 25th October 2023.** The total cost, depending on numbers, will be approximately £103.50 (tbc once final numbers are known).

Last year's Year 2 residential was a fantastic success – the children really enjoyed it! It would also be an excellent precursor to our 3-night residential in Year 4 and 4-night residential in Year 6.

I will be hosting a parents' information session, in the school hall, on Thursday 8th June 2023 at 5pm.

On the Tuesday, it will be pirate themed. Children may come dressed as a pirate if they wish too. They have a captain's stateroom, secret pirate cavern, and giant treasure game board to entertain the children with treasure hunts, pirate maths trails, English games and much more! The Wednesday will be nature themed. Children will explore the woodland, pond, stream and meadow allowing them to learn about habitats, natural art, creature study and classification.

Breakfast and evening meals are taken in the grand surroundings of the Main Hall and they will provide a packed lunch on both days (this includes their day of arrival). In addition, we will get hot chocolate and biscuits at nighttime too.

Please find attached with this letter a 'Residential Consent' form. This must be completed and returned to the office by Friday 16th June 2023.

Government legislation, which makes it a requirement that contributions towards the cost of a trip must be voluntary, does not apply to board and lodging for residential trips, though the activities themselves do fall within the legislation. In reality, if any parent opts for their child to go, but decides against contributing, the trip would have to be cancelled, as we have no alternative source of funding. However, if you are a parent who is on a low income and may require financial support, you may speak to Mrs Pankhania confidentially.
